GCSE Results August 2017

Our first set of GCSE results were very strong. In particular, student achievement in the most prestigious Ebacc Subjects of English, Mathematics, Science, Spanish, Mandarin, Geography and History was exceptional. The cohort of 143 students all took: English (Literature and Language), Mathematics, Science and Religion & Philosophy. Most took 10 or 11 GCSEs in total. Two took 12.

The highlights include:

Progress 8 Score is anticipated to be around 0.2 (confirmed figure will be published in January)

Attainment 8 Score for the entire cohort is 50.43

EBacc Entry rate is 54%

EBacc Achievement rate is 43%

75% of students achieved at least 5A*-C/4, including English and Mathematics

All students performed exceptionally well in English, with 91% achieving 9-4 and 23% achieving 7,8,9

In Mathematics, 82% of students achieved 9-4 and 19% achieved 7,8,9

82% of students gained at least the Double Award at A* to C; 100% of the 50 students who took all three sciences achieved an A*-C,

80 students took Spanish, of which 86% passed A* to C

8 took Mandarin, of which 100% gained A* to C

70 took Geography, of which, 64% gained A* to C

93 took History, of which, 76% gained A* to C

71% achieved a C or above in Religion and Philosophy, with 22% gaining A* or A

Number of students who sat the exams 143
